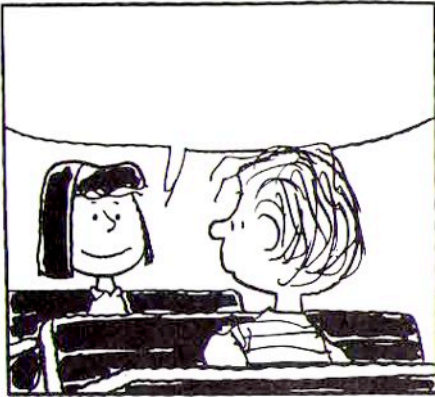


26.1. Write into the bubbles:
