<b>to sail:</b>	to go by boat
<b>cloud:</b>	white or dark spot in the sky
<b>to hear:</b>	to listen
<b>dark:</b>	black
<b>night:</b>	dark period between days
<b>through:</b>	across
<b>to die (-&gt; dying):</b>	lose one's life
<b>to try (-&gt; trying)</b>	do it as a test
<b>far away:</b>	a long way from here
<b>Lord:</b>	God, Master

**read** » reading (regular)  
**write** » writing ( silent e ist dropped)  
**run** » running (doubled consonant after a stressed vowel)

**CHANGE FROM THE SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE INTO THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS (=PROGRESSIVE PRESENT) by dropping the underlined word and adding the expression in brackets:**

- The birds never fly over the sea. (NOW)... *Now the birds are flying over the sea.* .....
