**to disappear:** go away  
**to wonder:** ask myself  
**to believe:** trust  
**funny:** strange

**3 TYPES OF FUTURE TENSES:**

- **Ing-Form:**  
We are calling the police when we are at home.
- **Will-Future:**  
We will see what it is.  
They won't believe.
- **Going-to-Future:**  
What are we going to do?  
I'm not going to walk home.
